This document provides information for the DTrade v3.2.2 release that incorporate changes to USML VIII, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVIII, and XIX.

Overview of Changes

The DTrade v3.2.2 release contains changes to USML Categories VIII, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVIII, and XIX as defined in Federal Register Notices [81 FR 83126](#), [81 FR 870340](#) and [81 FR 49531](#). These USML changes are implemented in the DSP -5, -61, -73, and -85 Forms and Batch Processing Schema version 7.6 used to apply for temporary and permanent export licenses for defense articles and defense services at the Department of State.

Common Schema USML and Version Update

The Common Schema version number is now v7.6. The new Common Schema used to submit DTrade cases directly via industry users' local software has been updated to reflect the changes in USML Categories VIII, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVIII, and XIX.

Updated Subcategory list for Category VIII, XII, XIV, XVIII and XIX

DTRADE has been modified as part of the President's Export Control Reform effort to reflect changes to the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) by revising Category VIII (aircraft and related articles), XIV (toxicological agents,

including chemical agents, biological agents, and associated equipment) , XIX (gas turbine engines and associated equipment) , XVIII (directed energy weapons) of the U.S.Munitions List (USML) to describe more precisely the articles warranting control on the USML. Additionally, this release updates Category XII (fire control, laser, imaging, and guidance equipment) of the USML to remove certain items from control on the USML and to describe more precisely the articles continuing to warrant control on the USML. The Department also amends USML Categories VIII, XIII (Materials and Miscellaneous Articles), and XV (Spacecraft and Related Articles) to reflect that items previously described in those Categories are now controlled under the revised Category XII or Commerce Control List (CCL). Also, this release reflects Department revisions to USML Category XI (Military electronics) to move items to the CCL as a result of changes to related control in USML.
