

Reorganization of ALTBMD, NACMA, NCSA and NC3A

Effective immediately, Active Layered Theatre Ballistic Missile Defence Program Office (ALTBMD), NATO Air Command and Control System Management Agency (NACMA), NATO Communication and Information System Services Agency (NCSA) and NATO Consultation Command and Control Agency (NC3A) will change as follows: **NATO Communication & Information Organisation (NCIO)**. Due to the volume of authorizations requiring amendments to reflect this change, the Managing Director of DDTC is exercising the authority under 22 CFR 126.3 to waive the requirement for amendments to change currently approved authorizations.

All currently approved DSP authorizations identifying ALTBMD, NACMA, NCSA or NC3A will not require an amendment to reflect this change. A copy of this website notice must be attached to the currently approved license by the license holder.

Pending authorizations received by DDTC identifying ALTBMD, NACMA, NCSA or NC3A on the license will be adjudicated without prejudice. A copy of this website notice must be attached to the approved license by the license holder.

New license applications received after **September 1, 2012** identifying ALTBMD, NACMA, NCSA or NC3A as a party to the license may be returned without action for correction to the new name.

A copy of this website notice must be maintained by the license holder and presented with the relevant license to Customs & Border Protection at time of shipment.

All currently approved agreements will require an amendment to be executed to reflect the name change/reorganization. The agreement holder will be responsible for amending their agreements. The executed amendments will be treated as a minor amendment per 22 CFR 124.1(d) and must be submitted as such. New DSP-83s must be executed as a result of the name change, as applicable.

Pending agreements applications identifying ALTBMD, NACMA, NCSA or NC3A will be adjudicated without prejudice. With the filing of the executed agreement, the agreement holder must attach a copy of this web notice as explanation for the name change in the executed agreement.
