

**OMNIDEA LDAs ACQUISITION OF
RTG-AEROHYDRAULIC INC.**

Effective immediately, the Space division of RTG-Aerohydraulic Inc. has been acquired by Omnidea Lda. These entities will now be known as **Omnidea-RTG GmbH**. Due to the volume of authorizations requiring amendments to reflect this change, the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Defense Trade Controls, Bureau of Political Military Affairs is exercising the authority under 22 CFR 126.3 to waive the requirement for amendments to change currently approved authorizations.

All currently approved DSP authorizations identifying the Space division of RTG-Aerohydraulic Inc. (Aerohydraulic) will not require an amendment to reflect the acquisition by Omnidea Lda. A copy of this web notice must be attached to the currently approved license by the license holder.

Pending authorizations received by DDTC identifying Aerohydraulic as a party to the license will continue to be adjudicated without prejudice. A copy of this web notice must be attached to the approved license by the license holder.

New license applications received after October 31, 2014 identifying Aerohydraulic as a party to the license will be considered for return without action for correction to the new name.

A copy of this web notice must be maintained by the license holder and presented with the relevant license to Customs & Border Protection at the time of shipment.

All currently approved agreements require an amendment to be executed to reflect this acquisition. The agreement holder will be responsible for amending their agreement. The executed amendment will be treated as a minor amendment per 22 CFR 124.1(d) and must be submitted as such. New DSP-83s must be executed as a result of the acquisition, as applicable.

Pending agreement applications identifying Aerohydraulic will be adjudicated as usual. With the filing of the executed agreement, however, the

agreement holder must attach a copy of this web notice as explanation for the acquisition in the executed agreement.
