Dear Mr. Chairman:

Pursuant to Sections 36 (c) and (d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of an application for a license for the manufacture of Significant Military Equipment abroad and the export of defense services, including technical data, and defense articles in the amount of \$100,000,000 or more.

The transaction contained in the attached certification involves the export of technical data, defense services and articles to support the manufacture of baseline "green" configured Sikorsky S-70i Blackhawk Helicopters.

The United States Government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
