Dear Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to Sections 36(c) and 36(d) of the Arms Export Control Act, I am transmitting, herewith, certification of a proposed manufacturing license agreement for the manufacture of significant military equipment abroad and for the export of defense articles or defense services sold commercially under contract in the amount of \$100,000,000 or more.

The transaction described in the attached certification involves the transfer of hardware, technical data, assistance and manufacturing know-how to Canada, Israel, Spain, and Taiwan for the manufacture of small caliber ammunition.

The United States Government is prepared to license the export of these items having taken into account political, military, economic, human rights and arms control considerations.

More detailed information is contained in the formal certification which, though unclassified, contains business information submitted to the Department of State by the applicant, publication of which could cause competitive harm to the United States firm concerned.
